## About ODM Community School

The Orissa Multipurpose Demonstrative (ODM) Community School was established in February, 2010. Its objective is to enhance and enrich the quality of modern education in rural tribal areas. It is managed by NYSASDRI, which is state level NGO with more than two decades of experience in the field of education. The school is running with up-to-date facilities, in order to establish a strong base of successful students and also to increase awareness in the local population. The school's curriculum will follow the Indian CBSE standards,



while its structure will be based on the English Medium School type. All subject matters will be taught in English, and it is believed that this will greatly improve the ability of the children to follow up with higher education. Today, 85 children are enrolled in the School from Class Nursery to Standard I (Nursery, Lower Kinder Garden, Upper Kinder Garden and Standard I are receiving education).

Location: The ODMCS is located at Kokuajhara, Kashipur, Gondia Block, Dhenkanal district, Odisha PIN- 759016, Phone: 9439973460

Objective: The objective of the school is to help the poorest children from the villages and tribes of the Dhenkanal district in Odisha to be in a position to one day compete with the national elite. The school has demonstrated great success, thanks to adequate facilities and societal/behavioral changes in the students.

Specifically, the objectives are:

- ❖ to set up a campus in which local children from the poorest families have access to world-class education from Nursery to Standard I
- ❖ to secure facilities in order to provide these children with adequate educational, safety and studying environments
- ❖ to expand the school to a second phase to reach more children and offer grades I to V education
- ❖ to raise awareness and concern about the importance of education in the local population

Current facilities include:

### SCHOOL BUILDINGS:

- ❖ 5 classrooms and an office room
- ❖ One indoor play-and-rest room
- ❖ 2 guest rooms with attached bathrooms
- ❖ Residential staff and care-taker's house
- ❖ Group toilet

### SPORTS AND PLAYGROUND:

- ❖ Indoor and outdoor games available



- ❖ Playground with Swings, See-saw, Slide, Merry-go-round and Sand-pit
- ❖ Plenty of room for all type of games (basketball, foot ball, skipping, Kho-Kho, Kabadi)

**TRANSPORTATION:**

The ODMCS provides 2 School Buses for its students' transport to and from the school.

**Achievements during 2011-12**

The ODM Community School of NYSASDRI opened its doors in February 2010. This innovative institution seeks to provide the children from the rural poor and scheduled tribe and caste communities with the best opportunities by educating them in English Medium advanced education, enlightening them about modern teaching methods, and opening and expanding their horizons. This is achieved through high quality teaching. Through English based global teaching, the children get a chance to benefit from top level, quality education.



A school bus service was also introduced to provide the community children with transportation to the facility and back to their respective homes in the rural areas. The teaching staff of ODM Community School consists of 5 teachers and 6 non-teaching employees. They have been trying to make the children feel at home and keep the school running smoothly.

Today, 85 children (52 boys and 33 girls) aged 3-6 years are enrolled in the school. The children are split by age into two Nursery classes, one Lower Kindergarten (LKG) class, one Upper Kindergarten (UKG) classe, and one Standard I class. This organization helps children learn and progress in the English Medium curriculum. Monthly examinations

have already been conducted, in order to assess the children's progress.

On the other hand, parent-teacher meetings are organized in a quarterly basis. This has not only given the parents the opportunity to discuss their children's progress, but also gives them a voice to make suggestions about their child's education. This interactive process involves parents in their children's education and helps the school to improvise and develop in the fields where improvement is needed most.

To make the children conscious of their environmental values through a "GREEN" environment, a "Sapling Plantation Day" was put into place, where 150 flower- and fruit-bearing saplings were planted on the campus. Annual sports, painting, and drawing competitions were organized in the school, and merit certificates and
