OFSDP



Odisha Forestry Sector Development Project is continuing at 06 no's of FMUs accordingly, 1-Dhenkanal FMU, 2- Hindol FMU, 3-Kamakshyanagar FMU East ,4-Kamakshyanagar FMU West,5-Sadangi FMU and 6-Kapilas FMU. The details FMU wise activities during the month of November 2020 are given below.



On 18th November 2020 a walk in interview was conducted for selection of staff for P-NGO team for batch IV under OFSDP-II. Selected staffs were deployed like one team leader; two DO for each FMU for Sadangi and Kapilash. They will be joined in respective FMU on 1st Dec 2020. In addition this MoU signed, orientation to staffs, preparation of action plan, set up P.NGO office has been done.



During this reporting period renewal of batch II FMU Hindol was completed.

Micro plan preparation: - Micro plan is a community based empowering process for preparing a road map for development and management of forest and livelihood enhancement of the forest depended communities. We conducted a Participatory Rural Appraisal (PRA) Exercise, that is a component under Micro plan for Kamakshyanagar East Range at Sarion Vana Surakhya Samiti (VSS) in presence of Forest Department, P-NGO and VSS Communities. In this project OFSDP-II prepared Village Social Map ,VillageResource Map, Well-being Analysis , Venn Diagramme through the PRA Exercises for the concern VSS by the help of Communities.

Survey & Demarcation:- Survey was conducted by Kamakshyanagar East team for Demarcating of VSS Assigned area and prepared maps by using GPS survey depicting the forest density , species , slope , area of plantation, Drainage line, Forest Resources and other information .It is very important for VSS boundaries and all treatment area before starting micro planning .

General Body Meeting :- Kamakshya Nagar west team conducted total 26 no's of General Body Meeting at 26 no's of VSS in presence of concern Member Secretaries P-NGO Staff, FMU Co coordinators.Preparation and assisted with Member secretary and VSS Survey Demarcation working group with VSS people for Survey and demarcation of assigned area and treatment area with boundary line clearance.

Livelihood Support to Kusupada VSS with the support of UCO RSETI –Sadar Block,

enhance their livelihood as well as their earning. So, on 16.11.2020 a training programme organized with support of RSETI, Dhenkanal and 28 nos of VSS members participated in the training program. It was a "10 days training program" conducted in Kusupada VSS.

The main objective of this training program is to provide handhold support to any unemployed youth in the age group of 18-45 years, irrespective of caste, creed, religion, gender and economic status, having aptitude to take up self employment or wage employment and having some basic knowledge in the related field can undergo train-

ing which is totally free of cost.

Unemployment is one of the major challenges in India, which has been facing in the process of its development. Lakhs of youth are entering the job market every year after completing their school/collegiate education. RSETI training is the post training follow up for sustained motiva-

tion among the trainees. The effort to make them rise to pinnacle includes:

1. Two years' follow up - Through regular correspondences, individual contacts, Unit visit, Village / Taluk / District / Branch level meeting etc.
2. Facilitating credit linkage with Banks for setting up of micro enterprises.

With it, soft study materials are being provided to students as well.

Odisha State Scholarship -

On the same, scholarship programme (State scholarship Govt. Of Odisha) is being applied and it's going on an appropriate manner. The assigned staffs are attentively working, as it is mostly helpful for the SC, ST and OBC students.

Renovation -

At the end, the renovation of "NSJS" college building is in progress, and the hostel buildings are being used as the class room for the timing. Side by side, Covid care centre closed-up and the whole campus sanitised and cleaned-up by the help of govt. workers with well-bred.



Swadhar Greh:



It is known that in swadhar Greh is mainly working for the destitute women, render legal support for helpless women. At present total number residents in Swadhar greh are fifteen women and four children. In the month of November five residents had been admitted and discharged one resident, who belongs to Village - Buhalipal, Po - Rasal, Dist- Dhenkanal. Present residents are being

provided all the facilities like- accommodation, vocational training, winter clothes, food, counselling

There had been organized a counselling session approached by the staff of Swadhar Greh to National Health Mission (NHM) department of District Head quarters Hospital, Dhenkanal. On date- 23.11.2020, for their personal development. This session was

useful & effective for the women as to strengthen and empowered them well. Empowered them to face challenges, difficulties, in their day to-day life situation as well as create awareness, & fight for their justice. Counsellor Mrs. Meera Dehury instructed residents to stay in Swadhar Geh as one family, helping each other, feeling of oneness in the home, rules and regulation to be followed strictly.

The resource person of the session was Mrs. Meera Dehury and Sri Narayan Sethy .In this month residents have been trained various vocational training such as mushroom cultivation, tailoring, nursery ,bamboo craft ,and kitchen gardening etc.

Hereafter residents of Swadhar Greh are happy to be here. They feel safe & protected in the home.



Family Counselling Centre:

During this month, focus was on the register of case records, online case register, sub-committee meeting, and telephoning, counseling services provided to the problematic clients through the awareness meeting, home visit and follow up visit. As we have observed that the family counseling centre provide counseling, referral and reconciliation services to women and children who are victims of atrocities, family maladjustments, social ostracism and also provide crises intervention and trauma counseling in case of natural disaster . Total 12nos. of cases registered, 01 Sub- Committee Meetings and 02nos Awareness Programme organized during this reporting period.

The British Public School:



With the reference to the pandemic situation, teachers are enduring the online classes through online application ZOOM as well. The virtual classes are being in a proper manner and students are enjoying

moreover in the British Public School, Kashipur . Total 45 students have been issued books and 13 students regularly attended online classes and rest of students not attended classes due to lack of devices and inac-

cessible area. Renovated broken boundary wall, beautification and regular cleanness of the school campus are going on.

Educational Complex for Tribal Girls:

Repaired boundary wall, window of hostel building, and cleanness of campus. Teachers are going to students house and rendering teaching to stu-

dents those are not availed virtual classes due lack of devices and network facilities. As repeated changing the decision by Government for

open schools so nobody will say when the education institution will be opened.



Rehaswiss Micro Credit Program:

In accordance to the self help program is helping to persons with differentially able in the financial assistance, counselling, vocational training, group efforts etc to them through this formed SHGs. Hence, all members are continuing the collection and deposit of a hundred rupees in the group's bank account every month. On the same, as the winter season has been started, they were also warned to be alert about the Corona epidemic and always take safety measures like use of mask, maintain social distance, regularly wash hands with hand wash, use of sanitizers, and not to go outside home without any cause etc.

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
